




### **Position Mgmt. Reporting Enhancements**



What?	Introducing the position hierarchy in Analytics
Why?	Customers and Prospects with an extended enterprise business model are likely to use Position Management and thus, improved reporting for Positions
Where?	Admin->Analytics Admin -> New Report
Key Notes	<ul> <li>The existing position reporting was limited to few dimensions that helped identify the associated positions to a person but could not represent the position hierarchy based information</li> <li>With this introduction, it is possible to understand from a report – <ul> <li>Complete position hierarchy with incumbents and primary for a position</li> <li>Combine positions and learning details to associated persons in the position hierarchy</li> <li>Match the application in presenting the data related to a position hierarchy at the manager level</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

#### **Custom fields on Charts**


What?	Component custom fields were not available for chart purposes in a report while they were available for reporting data. With this release, we have introduced the custom fields (except person and organization components) for chart purposes
Why?	Significant gap that needed a resolution. Highly asked customer enhancement.
Where?	Admin->Analytics Admin -> Execute report ->Use charts with custom fields
Key Notes	<ul> <li>We will be fulfilling the gap for dual natured components like Person and Organization in the forthcoming releases</li> <li>Custom dimensions for component custom fields are now available in all charts</li> <li>Derived dimensions using custom fields are also available in all charts</li> </ul>

What?	Ability to include profile QR code in PDF report downloads
Why?	The customer community wanted an easy way to manage their roster for ILT classes and up voted an enhancement to have the learner profile QR code printed in reports where that QR Code dimension is added.  They aim to combine the Saba Cloud mobile app Instructor capability and use it to scan and update the roster with these QR codes printed in a custom roster report.
Where?	Admin->Analytics Admin -> New report -> QR code dimension ->Execute report > PDF download
Key Notes	<ul> <li>Printing QR code may sound arcane but we have a lot of customers who are going to find this useful</li> <li>42+ votes for this enhancement!</li> </ul>





Key Notes	<ul> <li>Objectives were to         <ul> <li>refresh the look of the screens (constant since many releases now)</li> <li>reduce clicks and scrolling with focus on popular screens like the report execution screen with easy chart access possibilities</li> </ul> </li> <li>The landing screen for the Analytics admin has been enhanced to support both list views and card views</li> <li>It is recommended that customers should switch this ON in their non-prod environments</li> <li>The beta version can be switched on by the customer via the System Admin-&gt; Configure System -&gt; Services -&gt; Foundation -&gt; Analytics -&gt; Analytics (Beta)</li> </ul>

What?	Hidden reports add to the custom report license count today. With this release, we made a change in that policy and these hidden reports do not count towards the license count.
Why?	Popular customer feedback from Insights Analytics session
Where?	Admin->Analytics Admin -> New Report
Key Notes	<ul> <li>With the increased usage of Analytics, customers use the "hide" report feature to –</li> <li>Hide draft reports that are yet to be published</li> <li>Hide reports that are not relevant but do not want to delete them</li> <li>Hide reports that served a purpose but may have to be re-authored before using them again</li> <li>Basically, customers found interim reasons to use the "hide" feature leading to a paucity in the out—of-the-box report license capacity</li> </ul>
