# What's New in Saba Meeting 8.5.14

### Enhanced microphone test in audio setup

Prior to this release, the audio setup wizard in Saba Meeting allowed users to test voice using the microphone. The variations in volume were indicated by fluctuations in the volume bar graph. But, there was no option to record the test voice and play it back for actual audio confirmation.

In this release, the audio setup wizard has been enhanced to include a microphone testing capability that allows users to record the test voice and play it back.

Note: This enhancement is applicable to both Saba Meeting App client and Browser client.

The **Audio Setup** panel now displays the **Test Mic** button. When users click this button, the microphone starts recording the voice for an interval of 8 seconds and the button name changes to **Recording**. You can stop the recording at any point by clicking the **Recording** button. When the recording is complete, the button changes to **Playing** where the recorded voice starts playing.

**Note:** It is important to check if your microphone is working fine. If not, then you must select a different microphone and continue microphone testing, or check the volume level by using the slider embedded in the volume meter.




Figure 1: Test Mic




Figure 2: Record voice




Figure 3: Play recording

### **Audio enhancements for the App client**

This release enhances the audio experience of the Saba Meeting App client.

The echo cancellation, noise suppression, and automatic gain control settings are internally tuned to provide an overall improvement in the audio quality of the App client.

Users do not need to perform any additional action to improve the audio settings.

# New alert about unavailability of audio channels in Express client

Prior to this release, if a user wanted to speak in a Saba Meeting session and if no audio channels were available, then the Saba Meeting Express client did not indicate about the unavailability of audio channels. As a result, the user's voice could not be heard by others in the session.

In this release, if no audio channels are available when a user wants to speak in a Saba Meeting session, then the Saba Meeting Express client displays the following message to that user indicating the unavailability of audio channels:

All the available audio channels are in use. Please use the Raise Hand or the text chat option to request other speakers to deselect their mic, if not in use.

This allows users to know when the max capacity of audio channels is reached and no audio channels are available for them to speak in a Saba Meeting session.

Only when one or more of the remaining participants deselect their microphone, and if the maximum number of audio channels for the session has not reached, then the user's voice can be audible to others.

# **Enhanced markup toolbar for AppShare**

Prior to this release, there were some inconsistencies while displaying the flyout menu of the markup toolbar during AppShare and using the expanded AppShare frame.

This release enhances the markup toolbar during AppShare such that the markup toolbar is now displayed in an embedded panel of the expanded AppShare frame.

When you click the markup icon in the expanded AppShare frame, the markup toolbar is displayed between the audio-video options and the gestures toolbar. The markup toolbar is hidden when you exit the markup mode. See illustrations below.




Figure 4: Markup toolbar icon in expanded AppShare frame




Figure 5: Embedded Markup toolbar in expanded AppShare frame




Figure 6: Markup toolbar action menu in expanded AppShare frame

**Note:** The behavior of the mini AppShare toolbar remains unaffected with this change.

### New bookmarking support in Saba Meeting recording

Prior to this release, users did not have the ability to bookmark while playing a Saba Meeting recording. So, they could not return to the same spot in the recording upon subsequent launches if the entire recording was not played.

This release supports bookmarking in Saba Meeting recordings. Now, when users launch a Saba Meeting recording that was left without playing its entire duration, they can resume the recording from where they had left it in the last attempt.

On a subsequent launch, the playback recording starts about 10 seconds before the last stopped or bookmarked position in the recording. This allows users to regain the context of the recording when they launch the recording again.

**Note:** Bookmarking is supported only if the recording is played in the playback client. It is not applicable for videos played in the browser (MP4).

### New option to prevent skipping during playback

Prior to this release, users could skip portions while playing back a Saba Meeting recording and there was no option to prevent users from doing this action.

In this release, event creators have the ability to prevent users from skipping portions while playing a Saba Meeting recording using the new **Prevent skipping in playback** option for classroom events.

**Note:** This feature is applicable only to classroom events in a standalone Saba Meeting environment. By default, this feature is **disabled**. To enable this feature, submit a request. For more details, contact Support.

To enable this feature, Saba Meeting Administrators must configure the following new domain property under the **Event** category:

	The <b>Prevent skipping in playback</b> option is not displayed for classroom events. That is, users can skip portions of a playback recording.

	The <b>Prevent skipping in playback</b> option is displayed for classroom events and is selected by default. When the check box is selected, users cannot skip portions of a playback recording. If you want to enable this feature, this is the recommended property value.	
	Enabled and off by default	
	The <b>Prevent skipping in playback</b> option is displayed for classroom events and is not selected by default. When the check box is not selected, users can skip portions of a playback recording.	

When the **Prevent skipping in playback** option is available, the event creator can enable or disable it at the classroom event level.




Figure 7: Prevent skipping in playback

When Prevent skipping in playback is enabled, the playback client works as follows:

- · The Fast Forward button is disabled.
- The Next Index point button is disabled.
- Index Point drop-down displays all points, but any attempt to seek ahead, snaps it back to the current time.
  However, it can be used to move to content that has already been viewed. For example, if you view slides 1 to 8 and then go back to slide 4, then you can use the drop-down to go back to slide 6. But slide 9 and beyond will be grayed out until they are actually played.

• Any attempt to seek ahead using the position slider, snaps back to the current time. However, it can be used to move to a content that has already been viewed.

- Recorder
- Remote Application Host

The removal of these roles do not affect any Saba Meeting related workflows in an integrated Saba Cloud environment.
